GETF Window 2 Round 3 is managed by UNDP with funding support from the German Development Cooperation through KfW Development Bank focused on accelerating the deployment and adoption of green business solutions. The GETF is designed to drive investments in green business solutions and climate mitigation by private sector. Launched in April 2023, the GETF is a financing instrument which stands as Malawi's premier initiative to drive private sector engagement in the green economy. The facility aims to de-risk private sector investment by offering tailored technical assistance and matching grants. Its overarching goal is to foster the adoption and scaling of innovative, sustainable business models that deliver measurable environmental and social impact. The facility provides co-financing ranging from \$40,000 to \$300,000 in the form of matching grants, along with on-demand technical assistance of up to \$35,000. These resources support projects led by private sector companies with the capacity to develop or scale green business solutions, whether in the form of a product, service, business model, or technology.
